Spring is here and we all want to clean up our yards. At this time the Town of Kaukauna Does not require a burning permit. If you will be burning a large amount of brush please notify the Town of Vandebroek/Kaukauna Fire Department. Remember to be aware of wind direction. No burning of tires please.

We have been receiving complaints about trash blowing out of Veolia trucks. Please bag your trash as this will help. We will be discussing this issue with Veolia.

IT'S SPRING TIME!

If you like to get out and walk, please be aware of your surroundings, as well as the fact that you may not be visible to vehicles. To help keep residents safe, the Town of Kaukauna is offering reflective vests for residents to purchase. These vests are \$10.00 each and available in S/M & M/L. If you are interested, there is a vest at the Town Hall to view and try-on.



TOWN HALL RENTAL POLICY

Reservation of the Town Hall has increased considerably in the past year. This has prompted a change in the Rental Permit which is located on our website: <http://www.townofkaukauna.org/forms/index.htm>. The agreement used to read: "A key shall be obtained from the Town Clerk no sooner than one day prior to the rental date." The new policy will be; **'A key shall be obtained from the Town Clerk no sooner than the rental date.** If you require the key a day prior to the rental date (provided the hall isn't occupied by another resident), there will be a \$50 charge for the extra rental day.'

PERMIT FEE RESOLUTION

Changes are coming to our current Permit process. Town of Kaukauna Commercial Building Code Ordinance requires the Town of Kaukauna to hire a Building Inspector and establish fees for all permits issued by the said Building Inspector and has determined the Town Building Inspector program be self funding. The Town Building Inspector becomes an official agent for and is hired by the Town of Kaukauna and the Town Building Inspector is responsible for establishing procedures for obtaining permits and inspections. This Ordinance will go into effect on April 11, 2012.



FIRE STATION BID PROGRESS



The Town of Kaukauna Fire Station bidding process is complete. The second set of bids was publicly opened at the Town Hall at approx. 12:10PM March 12, 2012. The bid results were presented at the Town Board Meeting that same day at 7:00PM. The bids were approved. A special meeting was held on March 19, 2012 at which the proposal/contract for the new Fire Station for the Town of Kaukauna was reviewed and signed. Tentative timeline to begin building the Fire Station is May, 2012 with building completion expected by fall 2012.

- You have lived here for 28 days before this election;

and

- You are registered to vote or are registering today.

You may not vote if:

- You have voted in this election already.
- You are still required to report to a probation or parole officer because of a felony conviction.

SAMPLE BALLOT

OFFICIAL BALLOT FOR PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE VOTE & NONPARTISAN OFFICE & REFERENDUM

1. **VOICE TO ELECTIONS:** THIS BALLOT MAY BE VOICED UNLESS INDICATED BY ELECTION WORKERS OR CAS, AS AN ABSENTEE BALLOT THE BALLOT MUST BEAR THE INITIALS OF THE MUNICIPAL CLERK OR CITY CLERK.

2. **IMPORTANT:** USE ONLY ONE PRINT; DO NOT SIGN OR WRITE ON THE BALLOT UNLESS YOU HAVE BEEN PROMPTED TO DO SO BY THE ELECTION WORKERS.
